**Recognizing June 2025 as LGBTQIA+ Pride Month**

WHEREAS, the City Council of Foster City recognizes and proclaims the month of **June 2025 as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, and Asexual (LGBTQIA+) "Pride Month;"** and

WHEREAS, the City of Foster City joins the County of San Mateo to observe **Pride Month** to honor the history of the **LGBTQIA+** liberation movement and to support the rights of all citizens to experience equality and freedom from discrimination; and

WHEREAS, the Progress Flag is widely recognized as a symbol of pride, inclusion, and support for social movements that advocate for **LGBTQIA+** people in society; and

WHEREAS, all human beings are born free and equal in dignity and rights; and **LGBTQIA+** individuals have had immeasurable impact on the culture, civic, and economic successes of our country; and

WHEREAS, the City of Foster City is committed to supporting visibility, dignity, and equality for **LGBTQIA+** people in our diverse community; and

WHEREAS, while society at large increasingly supports **LGBTQIA+** equality, it is essential to acknowledge that the need for education and awareness remains vital to end discrimination and prejudice; and

WHEREAS, this nation was founded on the principle that every individual has infinite dignity and worth, and the City of Foster City calls upon the people of this municipality to embrace this principle and work to eliminate prejudice everywhere it exists; and

WHEREAS, celebrating **Pride Month** influences awareness and provides support and advocacy for San Mateo County's **LGBTQIA+** community, and is an opportunity to take action and engage in dialogue, to strengthen alliances, build acceptance, and advance equal rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, STACY JIMENEZ, MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FOSTER CITY, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL, do proclaim June 2025 as **Pride Month** in support of the **LGBTQIA+** community and in recognition of all **LGBTQIA+** residents whose influential and lasting contributions to our neighborhoods make Foster City a vibrant community in which to live, work, and visit.
