A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FOSTER CITY APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AUTHORIZING THE CALL FOR BIDS FOR CIP 301-700 FUEL SYSTEMS IMPROVEMENTS (2021-2022) AND FINDING THAT THE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) GUIDELINE 15301(B) – EXISTING FACILITIES

CITY OF FOSTER CITY

WHEREAS, the City's unleaded and diesel fuel systems are at the end of their useful lives and should be replaced due to safety, regulatory compliance, and environmental concerns; and

WHEREAS, the fuel systems are essential equipment and relied upon to provide necessary services to the community; and

WHEREAS, on January 17, 2023, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2023-06 authorizing the Foster City Public Works Department to advertise a Request for Proposals for Engineering Design Services for replacement of fuel systems in CIP 301-700; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2024 the City Council adopted Resolutions No. 2023-42 awarding professional engineering services for CIP 301-700 to TAIT Environmental Services, Inc for design and permitting; and

WHEREAS, Plans and Specifications for Fuel Systems Improvements Project (CIP 301-700) are complete and ready for bid; and

WHEREAS, this Project is categorically exempt pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(b) – Existing Facilities; and

WHEREAS, total funding in the amount of \$4,000,000 was approved for CIP 301-700 project budget; and

WHEREAS, based on the Engineer's Estimate, additional funding may be requested to fully fund the construction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foster City does hereby approve the plans and specifications and authorize the call for bids for the Fuel Systems Improvements Project (CIP 301-700).
