A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FOSTER CITY AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A TASK ORDER WITH HEXAGON TRANSPORTATION CONSULTANTS, INC. FOR ON-CALL TRAFFIC ENGINEERING AND TRANSPORTATION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$66,000 TO PERFORM THE 2023 ENGINEERING AND TRAFFIC SURVEY; AND FINDING THAT THE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) GUIDELINES §15061(B)(3))

CITY OF FOSTER CITY

WHEREAS, the California Vehicle Code requires that an Engineering and Traffic Survey (E&TS) be conducted at least once every five years so that speeding tickets issued by the Police, based on the use of radars, can be upheld in Traffic Court; and

WHEREAS, the last E&TS for the City of Foster City was adopted by the City Council on December 19, 2016 with an expiration date of December 19, 2021; and

WHEREAS, former interim Public Works Director Ray Towne extended the expiration date by two years in accordance with the California Vehicle Code and California Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices on October 25, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the 2016 E&TS expires on December 19, 2023 and must be updated for continuous valid speed enforcement; and

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2022, the City Council/EMID approved a Master Professional Traffic Engineering and Transportation Services Agreement with Hexagon Transportation Consultants, Inc. under which the City can access on-call professional services by Task Order; and

WHEREAS, Hexagon Transportation Consultants will conduct an E&TS across 33 segments and provide a final report documenting existing conditions, surveying methodology, results and recommendations, and E&TS worksheets for each segment; and

WHEREAS, funding has been budgeted from Account No.001-0910-431-4251.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Foster City does hereby authorize:

1. The Mayor to execute Task Order HEX-2023-11 with Hexagon Transportation Consultants, Inc. in the amount of \$66,000 to conduct the 2023 Engineering and

Traffic Survey under the Master Professional Traffic Engineering and Transportation Services Agreement; and

2. The establishment of a contingency in the amount of \$7,000 with authorization given to the City Manager, or his designee to execute contract amendments up to the contingency amount.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the Task Order, with minor, non-substantive revisions that may be approved by the Mayor and the City Attorney, and to execute any other necessary documents to effectuate the terms of the Task Order.
