RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council, by Minute Order, appoint one voting delegate and one alternate to be present at the League of California Cities ("League") Annual Conference Business Meeting to be held on Friday September 20.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The League's 2023 Annual Conference is scheduled for September 20-22. An important part of the Annual Conference is the Annual Business Meeting, where the League membership considers and takes action on resolutions that establish League policy where each member city is entitled to be represented by a voting delegate. Each city may also appoint alternate voting delegates, who may vote in the event that the designated voting delegate is unable to serve in that capacity.

Mayor Jon Froomin is the City's alternate Representative/Liaison to the League of California Cities and Vice Mayor Patrick Sullivan is the City's Representative/Liaison. Mayor Froomin has expressed interest in being the voting delegate and Vice Mayor Sullivan for the alternate.
